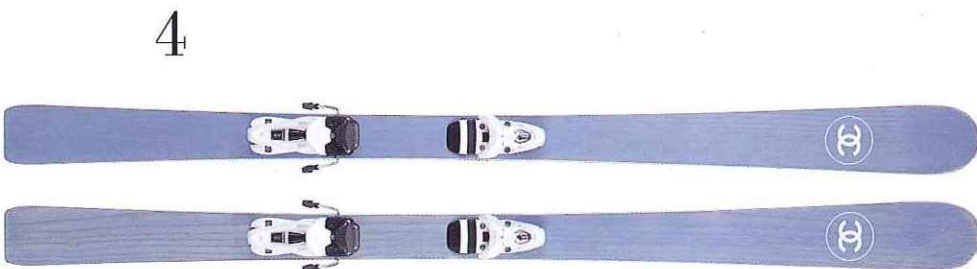

SLOPE CHIC

Whether you're in Hochgurgl or Hokkaido, stand out from the logo-carrying crowd this winter with these ultimate pieces of snow fashion

(1) Cut a dash in Zermatt this winter with this vivid, pink all-in-one, a typically graphic-styled, signature piece for this season from Swiss company Mover. mover.se (2) Chanel sports chic on and off the piste with these clean-line, black leather snow boots from Y-3, Yohji Yamamoto's line for Adidas. net-a-porter.com (3) Italian brand Moncler was the talk of New York fashion week when it launched its new city/après ski diffusion line, Grenoble, to an operatic soundtrack on a pier over the Hudson in February. Including pieces like this part puffa, part herringbone jacket the collection defines Moncler as the status symbol skiwear brand for this winter. matchesfashion.com (4) Designer skiwear can make for slippery ground if you want to be taken seriously on the slopes. We recommend these pretty but practical, polar blue, parabolic skis from skiwear stalwart Chanel. chanel.com (5) For style and substance choose Bollé's Quasar silver pinstripe goggles featuring an anti fog frame, Gore-Tex all weather vent to regulate the atmospheric pressure between the two lenses and a vermilion gun lens which highlights the contours of the snow. bolle.com (6) Whether tackling black runs in Courcheval or downing schnapps in Verbier keep your cool with this fur-trimmed hat from Bogner. bogner.com
